Role Description:

Gather, Communicate, Record

Before Launch on August 10:

Gather (recruit, solicit, implore) the people in your church to pray in a one hour time slot of their choosing. You may have to do more imploring for the early morning hours between 1:00 a.m. and 4:00 a.m.

-Our goal is to have every hour covered for 40 days/24 hours per day. Pray and do your best, the Lord will help you and us fill in the gaps over the city and county.

-Use the Prayer Guide to communicate what we'll be praying. You can download all documents at www.praylee.org.

-Married couples are asked to pray together for the hour, rather than separate.

Communicate to the church through the pastor in the pulpit and any other means necessary that is sanctioned by the leadership of the church. You cannot have too much communication—where the people have no vision, they will perish—keep them informed and in momentum as much as you're able.

Record our praying partner's names, time slots and email addresses (on one sheet) to Laura Hillstad at info@praylee.org. If you are unable to scan and email the sign-up sheet; fax it to John Moran at 239-628-4111.

-We will use this information to see where collective gaps are all over the county for prayer times and will use email to communicate needs, updates and potential next steps to the entire prayer team at once.

Post Launch After August 10 through September 19th

Gather challenges, successes (testimonies) from the people. As God begins to reach out to Lee County in response to our collective, unified prayers, there will be testimonies.

-Ask those sharing testimonies if we may share with the rest of those praying and the world the power of prayer in their lives.

Communicate Testimonies and/or challenges to info@praylee.org. **Record** the testimonies for your church to report back to the pastor the changed lives and the positive stories happening all around you so he/she can give glory through the pulpit or other means as they see fit.

Faith comes by hearing and hearing the Word of God—and God sized stories.

Final Point

As a prayer coordinator, it is vitally important you pray for three groups of people:

1. Your team that is praying.
2. Your pastor/leadership team of your church
3. The Leadership Team of Pray Lee County

Pray for protection and blessing of those praying and for the people in leadership, seeking to be obedient to the call of the Lord.

Above all, **pray** for the honor and glory of God Almighty in the lives and the very fabric of everything seen and unseen in Lee County, Florida.
